



**Robert Livengood, Council Member
City of Milpitas
Board of Directors
Bay Area Water Supply & Conservation Agency**

Robert Livengood was appointed by the City of Milpitas to the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency. The city is divided into two service areas, with the northeast area supplied with water from the San Francisco regional water system and the remaining areas served by the Santa Clara Valley Water District.

Livengood was elected to his current post in November 2000 and has served on the city council since 1975, including two terms as Mayor in November 1984 and November 1986. His council committee assignments include serving as a member of the Milpitas Redevelopment Agency; and representing the City of Milpitas on the Santa Clara Valley Water Commission, the Treatment Plant Advisory Committee, the East Zone Flood Advisory Committee, the Youth Advisory Commission, the League of California Cities Peninsula Division (alternate) and the Sister Cities Commission.

Livengood is the U.S. Director of Franchise Operations for Cartridge World North America, an Emeryville based retail franchisor. Previously, he was the Assistant General Manager of the Great Mall of the Bay Area, located in Milpitas. Livengood served as the Executive Director of the Building Industry Association, handling fundraising, government affairs, volunteer coordination and public relations for this 300-member nonprofit trade association. He owned and operated a 7-Eleven Store that generated \$1.4 million a year in retail sales. As a field representative for the Southland Corporation he was responsible for seven to 10 stores. Livengood was a manager for Lucky Stores and served the City of Fremont as a police officer.

Livengood was the top fundraiser in Northern California for the Muscular Dystrophy Association in 1984. He has participated in the March of Dimes Walk-A-Thon and "Jail or Bail" fundraisers for more than eight years. He sponsors the annual celebrity lunch for the Leukemia Society of Santa Clara Valley and volunteers with the Boy Scouts of America. Livengood is on the board of Outreach and Escort, a member of the Milpitas High School Booster Club and a board member of the Milpitas Foundation for Education.

He is a reserve police officer with the Milpitas Police Department and is a former reserve police officer for the City of Campbell. Livengood is a graduate of Samuel Ayer High School and San Jose City College.
