



**Chris Reynolds, Director

Chris Reynolds was appointed by Skyline County Water District to the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency. The district provides water to a 24 square mile rural residential community along Highway 35 (Skyline Boulevard) from Highway 84 to Highway 92, including a portion of the Town of Woodside and unincorporated areas of San Mateo County.

Reynolds has been a member of the board for Skyline County Water District since November 2001. Prior community service includes serving on the board for the Kings Mountain Volunteer Fire Brigade; chairing the successful effort to establish the King's Mountain Children's Center at the King's Mountain Elementary School and securing grants for the school on behalf of the Cabrillo Unified School District. Since 1992, he has served as a mentor, and organized and conducted tours of Bay Area companies and institutions, for the Graduate School of International Relations and Pacific Studies at the University of California, San Diego.

He serves as a Vice President of Comerica Bank, one of the nation's 20 largest banks, where he provides large commercial real estate loans to a variety of corporate, nonprofit and individual customers. Prior to joining Comerica Bank in 1999, Reynolds worked for Bank One, Bank of America and Security Pacific Bank.

Reynolds holds a bachelors degree in English from Maryknoll College in Glen Ellyn, Illinois. He studied finance and economics in the MBA program at Northwestern University's Kellogg School of Management in Evanston, Illinois.
