Irene O'Connell was appointed by the City of San Bruno to the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency. The city owns and operates its own utility, providing water to residential, commercial and light industrial customers in San Bruno and unincorporated areas of San Mateo County.

An educator, O'Connell was first elected to the city council in 1995 and is serving her second term as a councilmember. She serves on the council's water/well water ad hoc committee, along with the facility needs assessment, school liaison and stormwater committees. O'Connell is on the board of the Carlton Corners Association and is President and founder of the San Bruno Library Foundation. She chairs the Beautification Task Force and sits on the board of the City/County Association of Governments. O'Connell is a member of the legislative and the congestion management air quality committees of C/CAG.

She holds a bachelors degree in Liberal Arts, a masters degree in Education and a teaching credential from San Francisco State University. O'Connell taught sixth and eighth grades for over eight years at St. Veronica's Catholic School in South San Francisco. She currently volunteers as a school librarian.
