



**Matt Pear, Council Member  
City of Mountain View  
Board of Directors  
Bay Area Water Supply & Conservation Agency**

Matt Pear was appointed by the City of Mountain View to the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency. The city provides water to over 72,000 residents in an 11.7-square-mile service area. The city also receives water from the Santa Clara Valley Water District and the California Water Service Company.

Pear was elected to the city council in 2001 and served as Vice Mayor in 2003, and Mayor in 2004. He is currently chair of the Santa Clara Valley Water Commission and the council's Neighborhood Committee, and a member of the General Plan Update, Procedures, and Technology Committees.

Pear is the council appointee to the Moffett Federal Restoration Advisory Board (RAB), and the Project Cornerstone Leadership Team. He is the alternate representative to the Santa Clara County Emergency Preparedness Council and the Onizuka Air Force Station Citizens Advisory Committee.

Prior to his election to the city council, Pear served as a member of the board for the Northern California CCIM Institute, the Northern California Commercial Association of Realtors, and the Stanford Bay Area Charities where he also served as the San Francisco Events Chair and CFO.

Pear earned his Bachelor of Science in Industrial Engineering in 1981 from Stanford University. He obtained his MBA in Finance and Real Estate from the University of California, Berkeley in 1985.
