



**Patricia Mahan, Mayor
City of Santa Clara
Board of Directors
Bay Area Water Supply & Conservation Agency**

Patricia Mahan was appointed by the City of Santa Clara to the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency in February 2009. The city provides water from the San Francisco regional water system to commercial/industrial customers in its northern area and to residents in the southern area. The city owns and operates its own water utility.

Patricia M. Mahan was re-elected to a four-year term as mayor of the City of Santa Clara in November 2006. She was elected to the City Council in 1994, re-elected in 1998, then elected as Mayor in 2002 and re-elected for a second term as Mayor in 2006.

She earned her juris doctor degree from Santa Clara University School of Law and has had an active law practice since 1980.

In addition to serving on the City Council, Mayor Mahan also serves the City of Santa Clara as a Member of the Redevelopment Agency, the Sports & Open Space Authority, Authority Member of the Industrial Development Authority, and as a Member of the Joint Financing Authority of the City.

Regionally, Mayor Mahan represents Santa Clara on the City/Mission College Liaison Committee, Grand Boulevard Task Force, Peninsula Division of the League of California Cities, San Jose/Santa Clara Clean Water Financing Authority, San Jose/Santa Clara Treatment Plant Advisory Committee, Santa Clara County Cities' Association Board of Directors and City Selection Committee, and the South Bay Dischargers Authority.
