



**Patrick Kolstad, Council Member
City of Santa Clara
Board of Directors
Bay Area Water Supply & Conservation Agency**

Patrick Kolstad was appointed by the City of Santa Clara to the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency. The city provides water from the San Francisco regional water system to commercial/industrial customers in its northern area and to residents in the southern area. The city owns and operates its own water utility.

Kolstad is Vice-Chair of the BAWSCA board of directors. He was elected to his second term on the city council in November 2004. He is a member of the Central California Power Agency No. 1 Committee, Modesto-Santa Clara-Redding Public Power Agency, and Northern California Power Agency.

Kolstad chairs the Convention Center Liaison Committee and the Golf Course Committee of the City of Santa Clara. He also serves on the city's Audit Committee, Council Officers and Elected Full Time Employees Performance/Salary Review Committee, Neighborhood-University Relations Committee and Santa Clara Downtown Revitalization Committee.

In community involvement, Kolstad is a member of the board of directors for the Rotary Club of Santa Clara and Mission City Community Fund. He is a member of the Santa Clara Masonic Lodge #299 and the Portuguese American Club of Santa Clara County.

A graduate of San Jose State University, Kolstad worked for the Santa Clara Police Department for thirty-one years. He served as President of the Santa Clara Police Officers Association and of the California Burglary and Theft Investigators Association. Kolstad was a former director and board member of the Santa Clara Police Activities League.
