Ken Coverell was appointed by the Coastside County Water District (CCWD) to the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency on July 2009. CCWD provides water to the residents of Half Moon Bay and several unincorporated communities, including El Granada, Miramar and Princeton.

Ken Coverdell has been serving CCWD since 1992. He has served as President of that district's Board of Directors twice, has worked in its Budget and Finance Committee, and is currently a member of the Capital Improvement Committee.

Holding a Landscape Architect's license, a Landscape Contractor's license and a General Contractor's license, he has been landscaping in California since 1977. He and his wife have opened Blue Sky Farms, a retail nursery and coffee shop on their historic farm located on the San Mateo coast. They are dedicated to the restoration of California's native, drought-tolerant and sustainable landscape, "starting in your own back yard".

The barn and nursery were built green, demonstrating many water conserving and water recycling techniques for the landscape, as well as recycling and composting techniques for the food service industry. Their goals are: local, fresh, organic when possible, fair trade and sustainably.
